He is the youngest of 11 children and has 24 nieces and nephews. For the past 14 years he has been stationed in Elizabeth New Jersey working for RENEW International. He has studied at Laval University in Quebec City Canada and Institut Catholique in Paris France. He is a polyglot, fluent in Spanish, English, French, Italian and Portuguese. Fr. Alejandro is familiar with the Boston area, but this is mostly unfamiliar land to him. He has an architectural background and interests in music and choirs. Fr. Alejandro's assignment as a chaplain to the Spanish speaking population at St. Mary's is part-time; he will also be working on a project for Cardinal O'Malley. We are really happy to have him in the parish and in the rectory. We are now six priests in the house. Pretty soon we will have to put an addition on the big house. Please introduce and welcome Fr. Alejandro to St. Mary's.
