**ATTACKS ON GOD**

*Chinese police raid 'underground' Catholic parish*

Chinese police raided an 'underground' Catholic Church last week, disrupting Mass, and announcing that they had successfully stopped "illegal religious activity." The raid in the town of Heilongjiang occurred on April 20. It appeared to be part of a new crackdown on the 'underground' Catholic Church. Shortly before Easter, authorities had taken two 'underground' prelates into custody: Bishop Vincent Guo Xijin on Mindong and Bishop Peter Shao Zhumin of Wenzhou. The latter has been released; the former remains in custody.

My brothers and sisters in Christ,  
 A few months ago, I wrote about the rat problem in Waltham in my 133/1000 Club letter. Recently I saw a Waltham Cable TV program of a public resident's meeting held in October with the Mayor, a couple of City Councilors and the staff of different City offices. The rat problem was described as an epidemic at one point in the meeting. Nobody denied that it is a big problem. The officials expressed concern about the problem. They said it would take time to solve. They said that reports of seeing rats and infestation are coming from all over the city – not just one neighborhood. I also know that the city workers, especially the Board of Health, is working hard to combat the problem. I appreciate all that, but at the same time I am not sure that they are doing enough to solve the problem. Rat reports and sightings are still being mentioned all the time. I am not sure that they have had much success in reducing the population. We should be worried with the warmer weather coming and the uptick in construction, digging and demolition activity that comes at this time of year. The rats will have more food sources and will grow in numbers. I hope the city leaders will devote more resources and money to the problem. People who feel the same way should contact city officials. It would be good if they spoke about it more and let us know what they are doing about the problem. We don't have to live this way. If the city cannot combat the problem, maybe there should be a moratorium on all new construction and digging in the city. It will be better than the return of the bubonic plague. – Fr. Michael Nolan

## MIGRACION

La Oficina del Inspector General (OIG, por sus siglas en inglés) del Departamento de Seguridad Nacional (DHS, por sus siglas en inglés) emitió un alerta el 19 de abril de 2017 a fin de notificar al público acerca de una estafa en la cual se utiliza el número telefónico de ayuda de DHS OIG. Los estafadores se identifican como empleados del "Servicio de Inmigración" y han alterado su identificador de llamadas de modo que parezca que la llamada proviene del número de ayuda de DHS OIG (1-800-323-8603). Ellos demandan que la persona provea o verifique información personal de identificación, a menudo diciéndole a la persona que ha sido víctima de robo de identidad.

**Si usted recibe una llamada en la que se le demanda información o pago, cuelgue inmediatamente. Si quiere verificar si es realmente una llamada de USCIS, usted puede:**

Hacer una cita por medio de InfoPass en <http://infopass.uscis.gov>, o Usar [my USCIS](#) para encontrar información actualizada acerca de su solicitud.

Recuerde, los oficiales de USCIS **nunca le amenazarán o le pedirán un pago por teléfono o por medio de correo electrónico**. Si necesitamos un pago, le enviaremos una carta con sello oficial solicitándoselo. No haga pagos por teléfono a personas que se identifiquen como oficiales de USCIS. En general, le exhortamos a proteger su información personal, y a no proveer detalles acerca de su solicitud y tampoco hacerlo en un área pública.
