CLARIFICATION OF REPORTED OFFERTORY

We want to clarify how the collections taken up at the Masses are being reported in the bulletin. Each week, we report the collections from the *previous weekend* for all Masses except the 1:00 p.m. Mass; the collection reported for the 1:00 p.m. Mass is from *two weekends ago*. This is simply because the 1:00 p.m. Mass ends late in the afternoon and so its offertory is counted the following weekend. You can see in the OFFERTORY report above that the collections span two weekends.

For example, this bulletin reports a combined total of \$8,354 collected for Hurricane Relief at the 4:00, 10:00, and 11:00 Masses last weekend; however, you won't see the amount collected for Hurricane Relief at last weekend's 1:00 p.m. Mass until next week's bulletin. Hopefully this clears up any confusion about how the collections are reported.
