My brothers and sisters in Christ,

I am pleased to present the financial report for our fiscal year ending June 30, 2017. The total income for the year was \$861,090. Total expenses added up to \$772,951. This left us with a net profit of \$88,139. This is good news for the parish. Once again, we paid all our bills, made investments to upgrade and maintain the parish facilities, and helped out the poor and needy with donations and assistance. Your continuous and dependable giving has allowed us to continue our mission of preaching God's love and mercy in word and in deed. Your donations have also made it possible to invest in the Christian education and formation of children and youth in the parish.

INCOME: Our Sunday Offertory is just slightly down this year. At the same time we are grateful for your steady and consistent donations. A plan is in the works to establish an online giving program which will offer parishioners a way to make their donations via credit or debit card, rather than using cash or checks. This will not be in place this fiscal year. The After School Program has benefited from individuals and foundations who want to support this important work of educating and caring for the children of Waltham. This has kept the After School Program from weakening our financial stability. We are grateful for their generosity. I believe you could count on your hands the number of After School Programs in parishes in the United States where the parish does not have a school. I am grateful for the support and encouragement in doing extra for the children. We can never do too much for them. The worshippers at the 1:00 p.m. Sunday Mass have shown an interest in donating more to the parish through their weekly offering and their annual Harvest Fundraiser. I am grateful for their willingness to support the parish. We encourage everyone to continue giving what you can to support the mission of the Church. Thank you for your financial support.

EXPENSES: The highest expense we have is salaries. We pay for the salaries and taxes of 18 people on the parish staff. Some are full-time workers while others are part-time. These include the ordained and non-ordained. Many thanks to the great staff who work hard in serving the Lord and His Church! Please join me in thanking them for all they do when you see them. We monitor the costs of everything and try to save money whenever we can. Last year, winter lingered on and our heating bills increased by 12%. We continue to not let the parish fall into disrepair. The kneeler project and the replacement of the front doors of the church were two big projects that are still continuing into this fiscal year. We painted the chapel and most of the rooms in the Religious Education building this summer. A new floor for the stage in the lower hall of the church was also built.

UPCOMING EXPENSES: We will continue to watch our expenses and be conservative in our spending this year. At the same time, we know we have some big bills coming this fall. A steam leak in the undercroft of the Church damaged the organ, causing \$75,000 in repairs. Insurance is covering half of the cost so we will have to make up the difference. We also need to look
