My brothers and sisters in Christ,

This week we have published the list of donors to our Kneeler Replacement Fund. Thank God for their generosity! We were in desperate need for new kneelers in the back half of the church. Many thanks to Paul Landry and his crew for doing the work of building over 300 new kneelers of different lengths and dimensions. I am grateful to everyone who made donations for kneelers in memory of loved ones. Please know that I will remember them in my prayers this month. We still welcome donations for this fund. At present, we have collected \$15,605 in donations and have spent \$54,085 in supplies and labor - so any help is greatly appreciated to keep us on budget for the year. What an interesting time to speak about kneelers! Let us remember what the gesture of kneeling in Church is meant to express and help us feel. We kneel in homage to God. We kneel to express our vulnerability. We kneel to God who we put our trust in. The Scriptures help us understand this. Wise King Solomon knelt in the Temple. Daniel knelt three times a day to pray and give thanks. People knelt before Jesus, and Jesus himself knelt before the Father in the Garden of Gethsemane. Kneeling is a religious and spiritual act to be done with reverence. It is an act that can be uncomfortable physically, but all surrender is uncomfortable... although (thankfully) less uncomfortable now that we have new kneelers. - *Father Michael*

ANNUAL FINANCIAL REPORT

Last week's bulletin included the annual financial report of the parish. The report shows that we had income of \$861,090 and expenses and charitable giving of \$772,951, leaving a positive balance of \$88,139. Thank you for making this possible. Our financial goals remain the same: pay our bills, maintain and improve our physical plant, and invest in education and charity.

Próximos pasos para eliminar el DACA

Todos los beneficios de DACA se proporcionan por dos años, por lo que las personas que actualmente tienen DACA se les permitirán retener DACA y sus autorizaciones de trabajo (EAD) hasta que expiren.

USCIS decidirá, individualmente, caso por caso:

Archivar correctamente las solicitudes iniciales pendientes de DACA y las solicitudes asociadas de documentos de autorización de empleo (EAD) que hayan sido aceptadas a partir del 5 de septiembre de 2017.

Archivar correctamente las solicitudes pendientes de renovación de DACA y solicitudes asociadas para EADs de beneficiarios actuales que hayan sido aceptadas a la fecha de este memorándum y de beneficiarios actuales cuyos beneficios vencerán entre el 5 de septiembre de 2017 y el 5 de marzo de 2018 que han sido aceptados como de 5 de octubre de 2017.

Las personas que no han presentado una solicitud antes del 5 de septiembre, para una solicitud inicial bajo DACA, pueden dejar de ser aplicables. USCIS rechazará todas las solicitudes de solicitudes iniciales recibidas después del 5 de septiembre.
