**Archivar correctamente las solicitudes iniciales pendientes de DACA y las solicitudes asociadas de documentos de autorización de empleo (EAD) que hayan sido aceptadas a partir del 5 de septiembre de 2017.**

**Archivar correctamente las solicitudes pendientes de renovación de DACA y solicitudes asociadas para EADs de beneficiarios actuales que hayan sido aceptadas a la fecha de este memorándum y de beneficiarios actuales cuyos beneficios vencerán entre el 5 de septiembre de 2017 y el 5 de marzo de 2018 que han sido aceptados como de 5 de octubre de 2017.**

**Las personas que no han presentado una solicitud antes del 5 de septiembre, para una solicitud inicial bajo DACA, pueden dejar de ser aplicables. USCIS rechazará todas las solicitudes de solicitudes iniciales recibidas después del 5 de septiembre.**

## SAINT CHARLES BORROMEIO PARISH

My brothers and sisters in Christ,

This week, we present the Financial Report for St. Charles Borromeo Parish for fiscal year 2017 which ended on June 30, 2017. Total income for the year was \$194,176. Total expenses were \$203,332. This left a deficit of \$9,156. I am grateful for the work of the Parish and Finance Councils in trying to address the challenges we face. Please contact me if you have questions or ideas about the finances. The best way to contact me is by parish email.

**INCOME:** Thanks to all who donate to the parish on a regular basis. Although total income increased from last year, this was primarily due to a generous donation of \$40,000 by the Knights of Columbus. Without that, total income would have been down 10% from last year. Offertory is down 10%. Last year's report showed offertory was down 8.5%... the downward trend continues. We received a small rebate from the Archdiocese for meeting our Catholic Appeal goals.

**EXPENSES:** We paid all of our bills but had to dip into our savings account to do so. The same thing happened last year. This is a very concerning trend. If we deplete the savings, we will be unable to pay our bills. Total expenses were down 3.9% despite that heat and utilities both increased in usage and cost. This decrease was mainly because we requested a partial abatement of the Archdiocesan Central Ministry Tithe due to our financial hardship. This saved us \$8,617; however, this abatement is not something we can count on every year.

The challenge is that we are a small community with a huge physical plant, and the church building needs some costly repairs. The bills keep coming even though the headcount at Masses decreases. Please pray for the Lord's guidance as we continue to manage our financial situation. - *Father Michael*
