ATTACKS ON GOD

Beijing expels hundreds of South Korean pastors and missionaries

The authorities in three provinces in northeastern China have expelled hundreds of South Korean religious people and closed down their churches over the past year. The crackdown against religious activities came ahead of new regulations slated for February 1, 2018. The State Administration for Religious Affairs (SARA) announced new regulations on religious activities last month. Their aim is to crush underground Chinese Christian communities and stifle official ones, as well as prevent external missions. Strict conditions will also be placed on foreign religious personnel. According to the new regulations, only control under religious affairs offices will make religion livable and acceptable.

ON THE BULLETIN COVER

You have but one Master, the Christ (Matthew 23:10)

This diptych (2 carved, hinged tablets) from the sixth century depicts Christ flanked by Peter and Paul, and Mary and Christ flanked by two angels. Notice the similarities in position of Christ as an adult and Christ as a child - they are equal in manner of sitting and gesture. The child holds a scroll and the adult a manuscript. It is thought that this piece portrays the heavenly origin of Christ, as testified by the angels, to the message of the Gospel passed on by Peter and Paul.
