

**THANKSGIVING MEAL PRAYERS**

In Pope Francis’s encyclical letter *Laudato Si*, he writes about an “attitude of the heart” in which we accept each moment as a gift from God to be lived to the full. He writes, “One expression of this attitude is when we stop and give thanks to God before and after meals. I ask all believers to return to this beautiful and meaningful custom. That moment of blessing, however brief, reminds us of our dependence on God for life; it strengthens our feeling of gratitude for the gifts of creation; it acknowledges those who by their labours provide us with these goods; and it reaffirms our solidarity with those in greatest need.”

We have included some meal prayers for your benefit. You can give thanks using your own words but it is also good to know the common prayers. It helps bring people together in prayer. We know it can be awkward to pray when you are eating at the homes or with people who do not pray. You can always pray in silence and bless yourself. Also, try to get over the nervousness of praying at restaurants and public places. God knows that you are praying to Him... not so that others can see you.

My brothers and sisters in Christ,  
 We lost another good one last week. Fr Murphy, who lived and served with us at St. Mary's for two years, died on Wednesday November 8th. Yet we must be happy for him. He has gone to the Lord, the God who made him and knew him and will judge him. Though he was officially retired when he came to the parish, Fr. Murphy never stopped working or serving the Lord. You cannot know how he helped us younger priests in the house. To see an elder man continue to live out his priestly vows with zeal and joy taught us younger priests more about the priesthood than any seminary class. To see a man in later years strive to be a faithful Christian could not help but make us want to be better disciples. Last week, I just happened to be reading the letters of St. Paul to Timothy. St. Paul loved his disciple and brother with a great love. St. Timothy must have been easy to love. Those letters made me think of how Fr. Murphy's parents knew what they were doing when they named him Timothy... because he was easy to love. May Fr. Tim rest in peace and continue to live in that same love. – *Fr. Michael*
