Dear parishioners and friends, [reprinted from January 21]
 I hope you enjoyed the Christmas Season. I just wanted to give you a brief update of my treatment which is continuing into 2018. I have just begun the outpatient stage of the autologous stem cell therapy. Last week, I visited the hospital during the day so they could remove my stem cells from my body and refrigerate them. In the coming week I will enter the hospital as a patient and stay there for approximately three weeks. The treatment takes place only during the first week of hospitalization. Patients have to stay in the hospital after the week of therapy to recover and stay protected from infection. So I am looking at it as a undergoing a sort of semi-monastic experience. Once I get released from the hospital, I have to make visits to the hospital and continue to rest so my strength will return. The goal is to return to ministry in late Spring. Even though the therapy has turned into a marathon from a sprint, I can say that I felt really good since my last chemo treatment at the beginning of December. Last Summer and Fall, I tried to visit the parish once in a while when I felt strong and my platelet numbers were high. I also tried to write a short note in the bulletin every few weeks. This time it will be a bit different as it will require a longer absence while I get my strength back. Hopefully this longer absence will get me back to work sooner than later. Thanks for the prayers and messages. You have no idea how important they are to my physical and spiritual health. – *Father Michael*

Queridos feligreses y amigos,
 Espero que hayan disfrutado de las fiestas navideñas.
 Quisiera darles un breve informe de mi tratamiento, que continúa este año. Ya he empezado un tratamiento ambulatorio llamado "terapia de trasplante de células madres," yendo en el día para que remuevan de mi cuerpo dichas células y las congelen. Luego de la quimio, los médicos me las trasplantarán nuevamente. Esta semana que inicia ingreso en el hospital como paciente, donde estaré por tres semanas. La primera semana recibiré quimioterapia, pero debo permanecer en el hospital por dos semanas más para evitar cualquier infección y recuperarme de esta sesión de quimio. Para mí será una experiencia como si estuviese en un retiro "semi-monástico." Una vez que salga del hospital, debo continuar el tratamiento ambulatorio del trasplante y descansar para recuperar mis energías. El objetivo es que pueda retornar a la vida parroquial a finales de la primavera. Aunque el tratamiento se ha convertido en un real maratón, me siento muy bien desde mi última quimio a finales de diciembre. Tanto en el verano como en el otoño pasado visité la parroquia algunas veces cuando me sentía bien y el número de mis plaquetas eran altos. Inclusive escribí algunas notas cortas en el boletín parroquial por algunas semanas. Pero esta temporada va a ser diferente pues necesitare estar ausente por un período más largo para que mi energía y salud se restablezcan. Así, tengo la esperanza que mi larga ausencia me permitirá volver a la parroquia más temprano que tarde. Gracias por sus oraciones y mensajes. Ustedes no tienen idea lo importantes que ellas han sido y son para mi salud física y espiritual. – *Padre Michael.*
