CALL TO PRIESTHOOD

Jesus still calls men to be priests just as He called the apostles. Signs of a Vocation to the Priesthood:

- ✠ **Sense of a spiritual call by God** to serve His people as a priest. This spiritual call is experienced by a recurring thought; a growing attraction to the priesthood; a growing sense that one would find fulfillment by serving God as a priest.
- ✠ **Love of God** that manifests itself in a desire to give one's life in service to God's people.
- ✠ **Love of the Church** and her Traditions and a desire to celebrate the sacraments for God's people.
- ✠ **Love of God's word** and a desire to proclaim the Gospel of Jesus Christ to God's people.
- ✠ **Desire to serve** the people of God as a servant-leader; after the example of Jesus, "who came not to be served but to serve."
- ✠ **A heart that can listen** to others and a desire to be the compassionate, healing presence of Jesus to God's people.
- ✠ **Desire to deepen one's relationship** with God through daily prayer. Liturgical, communal and private prayer sustain the priest to grow in his love and dedication to Jesus Christ.
- ✠ **Generosity with one's time, talents and gifts.** Priests are called to generously give of themselves for the good of the Church. The Priest is called to be a "man for others."

Dear parishioners and friends,

I hope you enjoyed the Christmas Season. I just wanted to give you a brief update of my treatment which is continuing into 2018. I have just begun the outpatient stage of the autologous stem cell therapy. In the coming week, I will visit the hospital during the day so they can remove my stem cells from my body and refrigerate them. The following week I will enter the hospital as a patient and stay there for approximately three weeks. The treatment takes place only during the first week of hospitalization. Patients have to stay in the hospital after the week of therapy to recover and stay protected from infection. So I am looking at it as a undergoing a sort of semi-monastic experience. Once I get released from the hospital, I have to make visits to the hospital and continue to rest so my strength will return. The goal is to return to ministry in late Spring. Even though the therapy has turned into a marathon from a sprint, I can say that I felt really good since my last chemo treatment at the beginning of December. Last Summer and Fall, I tried to visit the parish once in a while when I felt strong and my platelet numbers were high. I also tried to write a short note in the bulletin every few weeks. This time it will be a bit different as it will require a longer absence while I get my strength back. Hopefully this longer absence will get me back to work sooner than later. Thanks for the prayers and messages. You have no idea how important they are to my physical and spiritual health. – *Father Michael*
