LENTEN REGULATIONS

Abstinence – Catholics over 14 years of age are bound to the obligation of abstinence. Abstinence is to be observed on Ash Wednesday and on all Fridays of Lent. On days of abstinence, meat may not be eaten at all.

Fast – Catholics over 18 and up to the beginning of their 60th year are bound to the obligation of fasting. Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are the days of fasting. On these days, only one full meal is allowed. Two other meatless meals, sufficient to maintain strength, may be taken according to each one’s needs, but together they should not equal another full meal. Eating between meals is not permitted, but liquids are allowed.

These Lenten regulations state the minimum requirements. Other recommended practices during this season include participating in daily Mass and fasting on other days.

CONFESSION OPPORTUNITIES EXTENDED

Please note that we have extended confession times during Lent. Confessions on Saturdays will be from 2:00-3:45 p.m. through March 24. Please see the full Lenten schedule on page 2 for additional information about regular weekday and evening confession times.

NOT SURE ABOUT GOING TO CONFESSION?

Please know that the weight and guilt of your past can be taken from you through the Sacrament of Confession. Many of us hesitate or struggle when it comes to receiving this healing. Please don't think the priests will think less of you because you have sinned. Priests also have to go to confession and are humbled whenever anyone comes to confession. Many times people don't go because they forget the exact format of *how* to go to confession. Please don't worry about this! The priest will help you (and see "TIPS" below). The important thing to do is to make an examination of your conscience and make a break from any sinful habits, then go see the priest. Christ will forgive you through the priest, restore you fully to the love of the Christian community, and hopefully bring you peace and inner harmony.

CONFESSION TIPS

Begin: Say "Bless me Father for I have sinned. It has been *<how long?>* since my last confession. These are my sins." *<state your sins>*

Penance: The priest gives you a penance so you can act in gratitude for receiving forgiveness. Penance is not punishment, though it may be given to you to restore justice.

Act of Contrition: There are various ones. This one is commonly used: **My God, I am sorry for my sins with all my heart. In choosing to do wrong and failing to do good, I have sinned against you whom I should love above all things. I firmly intend, with your help, to do penance, sin no more, and to avoid whatever leads me to sin. Our Savior Jesus Christ suffered and died for us. In his name, my God, have mercy.**

Absolution: The priest absolves you from your sins. Bless yourself when he makes the Sign of the Cross over you. Walk out in peace.

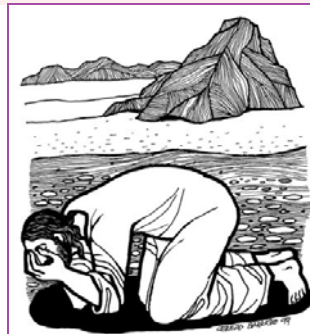
