RICE BOWL

Join us this Lenten season to support CRS's humanitarian relief programs through their Rice Bowl project (Catholic Relief Services: www.crs.org). Each of you can participate by taking a Rice Bowl with you and making a pledge of at least \$1 per day during Lent and the first week of Easter. In addition to praying, fasting, and almsgiving, perhaps you and your family can even cook one of the recipes attached to the Rice Bowl. Rice Bowls will be distributed during the Masses on February 10 and 11. If you cannot participate at these Masses and want to get a Rice Bowl, please call the rectory at 781-891-1730. All Rice Bowls will be collected at the Masses on April 7 and 8, the Feast of Divine Mercy.

LENTEN REGULATIONS

Abstinence – Catholics over 14 years of age are bound to the obligation of abstinence. Abstinence is to be observed on Ash Wednesday and on all Fridays of Lent. On days of abstinence, meat may not be eaten at all.

Fast – Catholics over 18 and up to the beginning of their 60th year are bound to the obligation of fasting. Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are the days of fasting. On these days, only one full meal is allowed. Two other meatless meals, sufficient to maintain strength, may be taken according to each one's needs, but together they should not equal another full meal. Eating between meals is not permitted, but liquids are allowed.

These Lenten regulations state the minimum requirements. Other recommended practices during this season include participating in daily Mass and fasting on other days.
